Dumb Charades is a popular game that involves acting out words or phrases without speaking, using only gestures and body movements to convey the message to your team or opponents. It's a fun and engaging game that can be played with friends and family. Here's how you can play:

**Setup**

1. Divide the players into two teams.
2. Create a list of words or phrases that each team will take turns acting out. You can use pre-made charades cards or come up with your own ideas.

**Gameplay**

1. Decide on a time limit for each round (usually 1-2 minutes works well).
2. Each team takes turns selecting a member to act out a word or phrase. This person is called the "actor."

6. If the team cannot guess correctly within the time limit, the opposing team gets a chance to steal the point by correctly guessing the word or phrase.

### **Rules**

1. No speaking or making sounds allowed.
2. Actors cannot use letters of the alphabet or numbers to indicate the word.
3. Actors cannot use props or draw in the air to give clues.
4. The actor can nod or shake their head to indicate "yes" or "no" if their team is on the right track.

### **Winning**

The game continues with each team taking turns until all the words or phrases have been acted out. The team with the most points at the end of the game wins. Dumb Charades is a game that tests your communication and acting skills, and it often leads to lots of laughter and entertainment as players try to decipher the gestures and movements of the actors. It's a great icebreaker at parties and a fun way to bring people together.

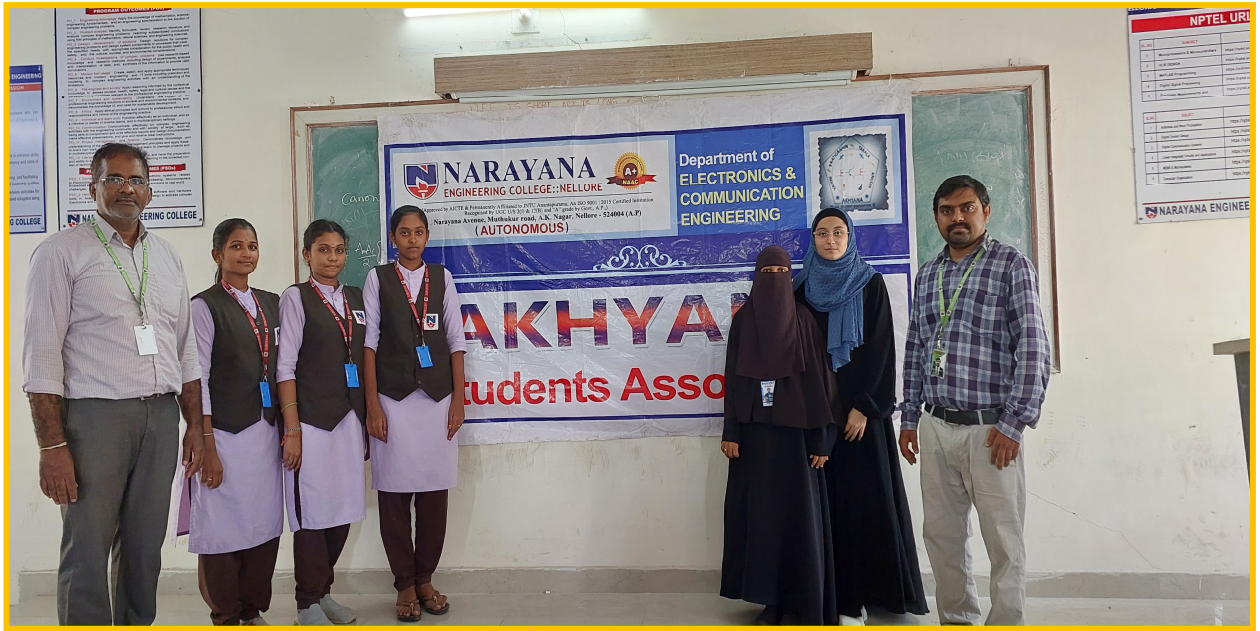
